The many facets which rest upon the shank represents the many facets of human ecology/home economics. The circular form of the ring represents the necessity of union of all facets to fulfill our purpose of enhancing the well-being of individuals, families and communities. Through this symbolism the ring increases professional pride and acts as a unifying force within the profession.
