Fred John's Park Leduc Multiway opposite the Leduc Gold Course 5725 Black Gold Dr, Leduc
A pleasant walk around the Leduc Reservoir

Telford Lake Boardwalk 4907 46 St, Leduc (at the end of 50th Avenue downtown)
Park at Telford House. A short stroll and lots of wild fowl watching. Telford Lake is known for its great rowing and kayaking opportunities and hosting various races during the summer
